His family is also sport oriented, and in the past, Drew has helped out with his sister's, Corinne's, softball games. Without a doubt, sports play a big role in Drew Kessler's life.

Drew's involvement in the community is more than sports, including holding several jobs and hobbies. From caddying at a golf course to snow shoveling to babysitting and selling Christmas trees,

To conclude, Drew Kessler is able to multitask and engage in multiple activities. He is an good student, actively participates in sports, and has many hobbies that make him the best person he can be. Whether it's through track or soccer or school, Drew Kessler always keeps up the pace.

DID YOU know....

Ryan Soroka - *Entrepreneur*

What were your interests growing up in North Caldwell?

- Since a very young age, my biggest interest growing up was playing baseball. From pre-school to middle school, playing baseball was, literally, all I could think about, and I tried to join as many North Caldwell/West Essex baseball teams as possible. Following that phase in my life, I started getting more interested in music. My parents got me my first drum set when I was in 4th grade and since then all I was able to focus on was my fleeting love for different music bands, music festivals and concerts. I was always just a short distance away from a plethora of live music scenes; Places in New York City, Hackensack and even Montclair which at the time had a thriving music venue (or arguably a dive venue) called Bloomfield Ave Cafe – It was there where all of my favorite bands at the time were constantly coming to play. Being that close to these music scene meccas made it even easier to fuel my interest in the music scene.

How old were you and when did you become interested in pursuing a career in the entertainment world?

- At the end of my 6th grade / beginning of my 7th grade, I started looking at all of these entertainment shows as more of a business opportunity while I was also taking part in the performing side. I was in a band (Agreements In August) with my best friend Frank Riley. Being that young, of course, I found it very difficult for our band to find gigs in which to perform. Eventually I figured out that the best way to go about getting gigs was just to



promote concerts/ shows of our own and to see how it went from there. During the second week after entering West Essex High School, I put together a show at a studio (then called Future Sound Studios) in Fairfield and the roster included my band, my brother Jason's band, and other friends' bands. This first attempt promoting concerts proved to be extremely successful for me and from there my interest and involvement in the entertainment world continued to grow. On a regular basis I rented Fireman's Hall, School of Rock and other local VFW venues where I promoted concerts on my own. Every concert had a different theme, which included "formal Dress Night", "Prom Night" and others. Young and older people (oldest couple was 85 and 89 years old) from all over NJ came to these shows.

How was The Soroka Agency formed?

- After a few years of promoting shows, my interests started to shift from promoting shows every few months to booking bands at different venues all over the US and Europe while helping develop their growth. I always saw being a booking agent to be similar to being a bass player in a band - no one ever dreams about being a bass player when you grow up, everyone wants to be the front man, or killer drummer, or shredding guitar player, however, playing bass is something that you fall into and could fill a void that is often open in bands and once you do it you fall in love with it. I realized that many of my friends' bands had managers looking for record labels. However, they did not

have a booking agent helping those bands set up shows or other opportunities to increase their exposure. My first experience was booking concerts was for a group of close friends from Fairfield who played with a band called Hollywood Ave. It was then that I started learning the ropes of booking tours. I decided to form the Soroka Agency because I started working with and representing more bands while getting better at the art of booking concert tours. Today, The Soroka Agency continues to grow.

Which artists do you represent?

- At the moment our roster has over 50 artists including America's Got Talent finalist David Garibaldi, Action Item, Alex Goot, The Story So Far, Real Friends, Citizen, State Champs, From Indian Lakes, Against The Current, among many other great acts. How long have you been booking bands?

- The first tour I booked was in 9th grade, so it technically has been about 8 years.

Have you organized any charity events?

-My first charity event was right after hurricane Katrina. I rented a recording studio in Fairfield. All the local bands donated their talent. It was again a very successful show and all profits were donated to Catholic Charities via Notre Dame Church of North Caldwell. Soon after that, I started to promote a regular concert series called "The Fight Against Cancer." At these shows, I would have regional and national bands perform - such as You, Me, And Everyone We Know, The Dangerous Summer, and The O-Matics - with some local bands at Fireman's Hall in North Caldwell, Future Sound Studios in Fairfield, or the basement at Notre Dame Church in North Caldwell. 100% of the profits from these shows was donated directly to cancer victims or several different charitable organizations.

Education background:

- I Went to Grandview Elementary School, then Gould School, followed by West Essex High School from which I graduated in the Class of 2010. I just graduated from the Wharton School of Business at the University of Pennsylvania, Class of 2014 where I received a Bachelor Degree of Science in Economics with a concentration in Finance and Marketing.

What is your career plan after college graduation?

- Right now, just taking everything a day at a time. We opened our first Soroka Agency office in Brooklyn, NY and I plan on seeing exactly what we can make out of this company now that I can finally focus on it 100% without dealing with school on the side.



growing herbs indoors

Everyone seems to want to grow herbs these days. And why not? Herbs pay triple dividends in good looks, good flavors, and good scents. The magic of freshly chopped chives sprinkled over an omelet or soup; the Mediterranean charms of fresh rosemary, oregano, and thyme; the intoxicating aroma of lemon verbena all make it difficult not to get passionate about herbs. And these rewards aren't limited to the summer garden. Even just a few pots of herbs indoors can supply you with wonderful flavors and herbal gifts through the rest of the year.



Herbs That Grow Well Indoors

Not every herb likes indoor life. Coriander (cilantro), garden cress, and dill are short-lived annuals that, when cut for harvest, do not regrow. You have to resow these herbs to produce a continuous crop. Three pots of each plant, each at a different stage (seeded, intermediate growth, and ready to cut), are usually enough. Forget trying to grow coriander, dill, or other spice herbs indoors for their seeds: They won't set enough to warrant the effort.

You can grow parsley in pots, but I prefer to bring in established plants from the garden at the end of the season. The older leaves will fall off, but the thick taproot will drive new growth from the center. However, parsley grown indoors from seed never reaches the size and productivity of plants dug from the gar-

den. That's why I dig outdoor plants in fall and bring them inside. Keep the soil around the taproot intact, and be sure to use a pot that's deep enough to accommodate the root.

French tarragon and chives in particular benefit from a cool period. When growth flags in winter, place them in an unheated shed or garage (or in the refrigerator) for a month or two; freezing temperatures are fine. When returned to room temperature and good light, they'll put out succulent new growth.

My mother grows herbs indoors in window boxes. She "plants" herbs in their pots in a window box filled with soil up to the rim of the pots. This system may seem odd, because the roots can only get at the soil outside through the holes in the pots. The extra soil prevents the plants

from becoming potbound, humidity and soil moisture remain more even, and the herbs seem to grow better. Also, the roots don't become so intertwined that it's difficult to rearrange or replace plants.

How to Grow Herbs Indoors

Herbs are sun worshipers for the most part. As expatriates of the Mediterranean region, most flavorful herbs don't thrive in the un-Mediterranean environment and inadequate light our houses provide. Herbs don't tolerate north-facing windows, or any window that gets less than four hours of direct sunshine a day.

Provide light. Even if your indoor herbs get their four hours of direct sunshine daily, installing supplementary lighting is a necessity. Grow lights will work if their light intensity is high enough and the spectral quality is right

PROTECT YOUR HOME



Although many of today's homes have security systems, there are further steps a homeowner can take to help prevent intrusion.

For example, making sure a home appears occupied is an easy way to divert uninvited guests. Invitations to intrusion include notes on the door, un-shoveled snow or an un-mowed lawn, accumulations of mail or newspapers, total interior darkness before a normal bedtime and an empty driveway or carport with no vehicles present.

Make the house look lived in even when away by alternating timed lighting and radios and having neighbors pick up the newspaper or mail is a critical security measure. To discourage intruders, also keep doors and windows locked, especially at basement and first-floor levels or where the home is accessible from a tree, porch or other structure. Inside doors that lead to the basement or garage should also be kept locked.
