Breaking Away from the Crowd

team Chelsea FC in the Barclay's Premier English League. Jake has a younger brother, Zach, whom he takes to the turf field and helps him improve on his soccer abilities. Other interests of Jake include golf, as he was on the varsity team and caddied at Mountain Ridge Country Club. Although Jake does enjoy the sport of soccer, he does not expect that he will play it competitively in college.

From a culmination of his dad's mentorship, his determination and love for soccer, the support of his teammates, and his great leadership abilities, Jake Gilbert has become one of the most successful players on the West Essex Boys' Varsity Soccer Team. And by sticking with the team and leading it to victory, Jake Gilbert has shown his talent and skill, breaking apart from the crowd and showing the world that he is different from everyone else.

It takes a courageous person to break away from the mainstream. A person must be brave enough to carve their own path, to do something different for themselves. Jake Gilbert is one of these people. By making the decision not to play club soccer, West Essex has benefitted because of Jake's decision. Through his leadership and communication skills, Jake has become one of the most influential and vital members on the soccer team.

Jake was not supposed to be a soccer player. His dad, Rick, was into football, but he started Jake off in soccer at the age of four. As he was faster than most kids, Jake excelled at soccer in his youth, being able to dodge defenders as he darted up the field. He grew up playing on North Caldwell's travel team, "The Heat", and worked his way up the ranks until he made it to the West Essex High School Boys' Varsity Soccer Team. It's also that time when we make our New Year's resolutions. I love the concept. It forces us to do a self-evaluation. We assess ourselves, examine what is working, what needs to be improved and pledge to make the necessary changes. It's kind of a cleansing. And that's a good thing after all the excesses we had from Thanksgiving through to January 1.

On January 1st Council President Cindy Santomauro, Councilman John Chiaia and I were sworn in. For that we are very grateful. I am extremely fortunate to have Cindy, John and our other council members Frank Astorino, Art Rees, Josh Raymond and our newest addition, Bob Kessler, to work with to serve our community. I speak for all of us when I say that we vow to do our very best for North Caldwell and for you our residents who have given us this charge. We will never take it for granted.

We have a busy agenda this year. We are progressing with our negotiation with the Walker Family for the acquisition of Walker's Pond, that patch of land in the center of town which has meant so much to our residents in the past and which we want to pass on to our newest and future neighbors for years to come.

We are also, in conjunction with the North Caldwell Recreation Foundation Inc, working on building a turf field. Last March at the Mayor's Ball, through the generosity and hard work of all of you, we raised \$80,000. The projected cost is between \$1.2 million and \$1.8 million so it will still have to be bonded. We are committed to getting this done as soon as we can.

As I did when I was sworn in back in 2011, I am planning to have the Board of Education, Planning and Zoning board, senior citizens group and other boards and organizations meet with the Governing Body at an open meeting to discuss better ways to work together. I have also instituted a 5 year long range planning program. Every Council Member chairs one of our six standing committees: legal and ordinance, finance, personnel, public safety, public works and recreation. Each, with the assistance of Borough professionals and personnel, will write reports projecting our needs and ways to accomplish them in the next five years. This will allow us to be more proactive instead of reactive and will greatly assist us in putting together a sound budget and making responsible future decisions for North Caldwell.

I wish everyone a happy and healthy 2015.

ROOSTER COMB INJECTIONS FOR JOINT PAIN - A NEW DAWN FOR ARTHRITIS PATIENTS?

Rooster comb injections is the description commonly used to describe the use of artificial synovial fluid injected into the joint to ease the pain and stiffness of arthritis.

The modern injections are all manufactured in a lab controlled biochemical process but the original versions were extracted from the combs of cockerels or roosters and the name has stuck. The formal term for this kind of injection treatment is viscosupplementation. "Visco" because the injected fluid is very thick, viscous and sticky - and supplement because the idea is to boost the joints own remaining synovial lubrication fluid and improve the function of the joint.

Viscosupplement drugs are given by injection into the painful joint. Sometimes one injection is needed, sometimes three or more at regular intervals. Not all patients benefit but those that do tend to see a big improvement over the months after injection.

If the benefit happens then most people see good relief of pain and stiffness that can last for 6 months or more. Some have even had their names removed from surgery waiting lists - having previously thought they were he added for joint replacement surgery.



Tips for Taking Better Photographs of Your Children

Photographing kids is one of the most rewarding parts of photography for parents. But knowing how to photograph children can be quite tricky. And as we all know kids are not always the easiest to photograph! So how can you make sure your memories are captured just as perfectly as you remember them?



Here are some basic tips that will help you capture beautiful photographs of your children:

1. Before the shoot. Invest in a prime lens: 50mm or 35mm. Prime lenses are fixed focal ranges. With fixed lenses you can't zoom in or out. The wonderful thing about this lens is the low aperture, which gives you that blurry background and makes for beautiful portraits.

2. Plan the location and set the stage before you add in the kids. Take a test shot and see if there is anything distracting in the background, like a possible branch sticking out of someone's head or a trash can in the background.

Also, plan your wardrobe! Be sure to wear white or a light colors that reflects light. The last thing you want to see in your child's baby blue eyes is the reflection from your orange or bright colored shirt.

3. Take photos when light is best, early morning or late afternoon, before sunset. But keep in mind after a long day of school,

kids may not be their happiest for photos (I may have learned this one the hard way!).

4. Dress for success, plan outfits and choose colors that compliment your subjects. I tend to stick with muted down colors, like light blue, greys, creams or pale pink. I avoid bright patterns, logos or character t-shirts for photos. I also recommend avoiding neon colors for photos.

5. Props. Bring books, stuffed animals, flowers...this helps keep little ones engaged and keeps little hands busy.

6. Quality is found in quantity. Shoot away...nothing to lose and hopefully you will find a gem!

7. Speak to your kids from behind the camera. Tell them something funny, share a silly story...and be ready to click. AND no cheese please!

8. Get down at their level and get close. Remember it's about your kids, not the background. Also be creative, start close and then pull away. Try all different

angles...break the rules! You might just come up with something magical.


9. When shooting outside, the green cast from the grass can be a problem. Use a light colored blanket to reflect light back onto your subjects.

10. Stay in the shade...it's always best to place your subjects in full shade.

When shooting indoors, the less overhead lighting the better, use a flash instead, but be sure to bounce your flash. Aim your flash at the ceiling above or the adjacent wall, not at your subject. This provides a softer, more natural light.

Natural light is always the best option. Use window light or an open door for natural light.

11. In almost all portraiture and people photography, focusing on the eyes is important. Also look for catch lights in your subject's eyes. Catch lights are the light source that causes a reflection in a person's eyes. Or if you want to be formal,



"light source that causes a specular highlight in a subject's eye in an image."

They show up beautifully for portrait photography and are often considered a very desirable part of a portrait.

12. Remember to take breaks. Kids have short attention spans. You will probably get the best photos at the very beginning and at the end once they think the "photos" are over.

13. Don't put too much pressure on having everyone looking at the camera. Kids come alive when they do what they love. Candid photos are my favorite. These are the moments that can create great images, so let them be themselves.

14. Exist in your photos. Be sure to take the time to make regular cameo appearances in your photos. I promise you, you will not regret it and your children will adore those photos the most!

HOME IMPROVEMENT matters

You've decided you want to go ahead with your dream of expanding your kitchen and adding a "great room" to the back of your home. You've called three General Contractors ("GCs") for bids. One you found working in the neighborhood and you like the work you see so far. Another was a recommendation from a friend who used and liked them and the third you've seen in the area for years. All are licensed and insured. Now you need bids!

In requesting a bid, you need to understand that your project is going to involve multiple trades and needs to tie into existing



systems in your house, like the air conditioning or baseboard heating. You can expect that the GC bidders will need to visit your home several times with different trades. This way the electrician can review the existing service, the AC specialist can determine if your current AC unit can handle the added area and so on. More details about the existing site means a thorough bid (and less surprises later) for you. It's not unusual for a bid to take a few weeks or more for complex projects. It's also not uncommon for a bid to be refined over several passes so that both home owner and GC understand the project the same way. Never be afraid of asking for more information in your bid!

So what do you look for in a bid? Can you, and should you, compare them apples-to-apples and just look for the best price? To be honest, probably not. Depending on the level of detail in the plans (and some architects provide more detail than others), different GCs will implement the project differently and you need to determine what "implementation" is best for you. Most GCs will provide a detailed bid that gives you a list of the materials included and the work to be performed, often broken down by trade. More information here is better (see below) and it's not unusual for bidders to include "allowance item" costs along with materials that you will need to supply or pick out.

Allowance items are items that have not been picked by you before the bid, but need to be accounted for. For example, if you needed a new garage door, but hadn't picked out a style yet, your contractor would include the installation cost, but might give you an **allowance** of \$500 to purchase the garage door itself. This gives you a budget and if you find a \$600 door you like, the contractor treats the difference as an extra. **Customer supplied** are items you supply. Typically, these are where a "decorative" decision is required. Hanging lighting fixtures are a great example. The bidding contractor includes installation, but it's easier for you buy the light when you find what you like.

Each bidder should also explain how they handle **changes and additions**: Most of us have a hard time taking a 2-dimen-

sional drawing and visualizing the finished project in our head, so changes and improvements happen. For example, say you want to change a swinging door to a sliding door. How will your contractor handle the change. Do you get a credit for the swinging door? Can you make a change after the door is actually installed? Understand how changes are approved, implemented and priced for each bidder.

Bids should also note **work that is not included**. For example, if you have added to the foundation of your home, some bushes and landscaping probably got removed. Restoring this after the project may be included, or might be something you want your own landscaper to do. Either way, your bid should spell out work that's going to be needed, but is not included.

Next month we'll continue to discuss how to turn your bid into a budget you can work with.






