## Pushing the Limits

Pole vaulting is a spectacle. How else can you describe the action of people sprinting with giant poles and propelling themselves ten feet (in some cases fifteen to twenty feet) in the air, over a bar, without knocking it down? And there are very few who can do it. In fact, pole vaulting is one of the hardest sports out there; it requires values like strength, determination, balance, and extremely precise coordination, among many others. Resident Luke Traverso, however, is highly skilled at it. Ultimately, this is figurative of how he has continued to push himself as an athlete, a student, and an engineer, as well as an active member of his church.

Pole vaulting was not an activity Luke knew he wanted to do when he first entered high school. He originally joined the Spring Track team as a Freshman at West Essex for long-distance running, but realized he wanted to try his hand at pole vaulting when he saw others doing it. "Why would I run in circles when I could push myself over

a bar 10 feet in the air with a giant pole?" Luke said in an interview.

However, Luke didn't realize exactly how difficult it was going to be. "At first, it was really annoying." He began his training 3 weeks before the 1st meet, but didn't make it over the bar successfully until his 3rd meet.

He now takes lessons for pole vaulting at Apex Vaulting in Fairfield, which he started in his sophomore year, along with the other members of his team. The pole vaulting season doesn't begin for the school until spring, but the athletes practice all year round to keep in shape; in Luke's case, he practices two days per week. Also, he conditions for the sport 6 times a week.

Events for pole vaulting are held at every spring track meet, but in the winter West Essex vaulters only participate Invitationals, Groups, and Sectionals.

The West Essex track was recently renovated, and the pole vaulting track was moved to make it easier. Now, the sun isn't in the athletes eyes when they are practicing.

Luke said that he prefers indoor vaulting to outdoor. With outdoor pole vaulting, conditions such as wind have to be accounted for, but indoor is purely based on skill.

In pole vaulting, there are many techniques that can be used, but West Essex tries to focus on smooth and controlled jumps. This ensures safety for the younger athletes.

Luke's personal record is 10 feet high, which he achieved this past summer at the annual Beach Vault competition in Seaside Heights. The best High School pole vaulter in the state of New Jersey has jumped over 14 feet high, and the

world record holder achieved a whopping height of 21 feet and 8 inches.

As a junior, Luke is currently in what is arguably the most important and difficult year of high school. Through taking multiple Advanced Placement classes as well as searching for colleges, Luke definitely has a lot on his plate.

Like many of the other members of his family, Luke has a passion for engineering. Both his parents and his brother studied engineering throughout college. His mother, Cindy, studied biochemical engineering, and is now a math teacher at Oak Knoll in Summit. His father, Jim, studied engineering and works at JPMorgan Chase. Mark, his brother, who graduated from Virginia Tech, is currently working at General Motors. As a result of these influences, Luke has grown to like engineering as well. But his family isn't the only reason that he is so interested in this career field. Much of his love for mechanics has spurred from his own interaction with structures and machines.

In school, Luke has taken three levels of CAD (Computer Aided Drafting), and his family owns a 3D printer. He and the other members of his family have used the printer to make parts to fix things around the house, pieces for school projects, and even gifts!

When he was younger, Luke tinkered around with Legos, which helped him gain interest in taking things apart and putting them back together.







**Sonali Goil, a senior at West Essex High School, stays connected with her native Indian roots every week by traveling 10 away miles from her home. As a young Indian girl, Sonali’s parents wanted to instill in her a part of their culture where their daughter would remember where her family came from. 10 miles down the road is the Arya Dance Academy in Parsippany, a dance school that teaches Indian Dance. Her dance school is the biggest South Asian Dance academy in the United States.**

When Sonali was five years old, she began taking ballet and Indian dance classes. Her love for the upbeat and lively classes led her to further pursue Indian dance.

Indian Dance provides Sonali with an outlet to remove herself from the stressful school environment and brings her to place where she is surrounded by her friends and invigorating energy.

At the dance academy, Sonali pursues a type of Indian dance known as Filmi Fusion. This class is a unique style type of dance that blends Bollywood music with the trendy songs playing in India. The class incorporates a mix of simple dance moves with complicated ones. Over the years, Sonali has adapted to the rhythm with which one must stay in sync.

Having taken the classes since she was 5, Sonali qualified for the competition team when she was 14. The competition team at Arya, known as “troupe” is a demanding course that requires extensive training and traveling to different competitions regularly. Each year, Sonali learns 10 different dances and performs them all at a recital at the end of year.

The instructors who teach Sonali and her dance team are dancers from India. Most of them are trained to teach a specific type of dance.

On stage, Sonali must wear a sophisticated costume for competitions known as a “lehenga.” A lehenga is an ornamented dress. This intricate costume is embellished with detailed embroidery and used with expensive fabrics. For each competition, Sonali receives a custom fit lehenga. In addition to an elaborate outfit, the makeup used in Indian Dancing is very colorful and bold. Sonali wears bright lipstick and flamboyant eye shadows.

Sonali and her competition team have performed at the Macy’s Flower Day Show, Lincoln Center in front of the Indian, and many prestigious dance competitions such as Naya Andaz and Naach Revolution. In 2014, Sonali’s team was featured on Dance India Dance, a renowned Indian Dance channel that broadcasts in India. The dance troupe team has earned many accolades through the competitions at which they compete. Some of their awards include best choreography and best costume. Since Sonali has been on the team, troupe has never received less than third place at any of their competitions. Sonali hopes that Indian Dance will always remain a part of her life, even when she goes to college next fall. One day Sonali aspires to teach her own Indian dance class and to instill the passion she has for Indian Dance to her own children.

Aside from dance, Sonali is passionate about pencil drawing. In addition to her achievements in dance, Sonali’s devotion to her academic studies has earned her honorable recognitions in the National Honor Society as the fundraising advisor, National Art Society, World Language Honor Society, and National Social Studies Society. She is also an active member of key club, the Red Cross committee and the Spanish club. It will be exciting to see what the future holds for this remarkable young lady.

### Ingredients


- 1 cup almonds (roasted unsalted)

- 1 Tbs raw honey

### Instructions

Combine the almonds, cacao powder, and ¼ cup of the shredded coconut together in a food processor. Process into a fine powder. Add in the soaked dates, coconut oil, and honey. Pulse until a dough-like consistency forms. Roll batter into small bite-size balls. Then roll balls through a bowl with the remaining shredded coconut to coat. Store in an airtight container or freezer to preserve freshness!



Traditional IRAs and Roth IRAs 2015:

**Q: How do I make a gift to a child for their Traditional IRA or Roth IRA contributions?**

**A:** The type of individual retirement account (IRA) that you choose can significantly affect you and your family's financial future, so it's worth understanding the differences between Traditional IRAs and Roth IRAs. Here are the key considerations:

Anyone with earned income, who is younger than 70½, can contribute to a Traditional IRA. Roth IRAs, however, have income-eligibility restrictions. Single tax filers, for example, must have modified adjusted gross incomes of less than \$131,000 in 2015 to contribute to a Roth IRA.

Both Traditional and Roth IRAs provide tax breaks, but it's a matter of timing when you get to claim them. Traditional IRA contributions are deductible against the current year's federal income and

withdrawals from the IRA are taxed at ordinary income tax rates. Roth IRAs provide no immediate tax break for contributions, but earnings and withdrawals are generally tax-free.

One major difference between Traditional IRAs and Roth IRAs is when funds must be withdrawn. Traditional IRAs call for Required Minimum Distributions (RMDs) to start at age 70½. Roth IRAs, on the other hand, don't mandate withdrawals during the owner's lifetime. So, in retirement, if you don't need the money, Roth IRAs can continue to grow tax-free throughout your lifetime, making them ideal wealth-transfer vehicles.

Beneficiaries of Roth IRAs don't owe income tax on withdrawals and can stretch out distributions over many years. Both Traditional and Roth IRAs

allow owners to begin taking penalty-free, "qualified" distributions at age 59½. However, Roth IRAs require that the first contribution be made at least five years before qualified distributions begin.

For parents and grandparents that have significant assets, they should consider making gifts to a child or grandchild with earned income. The child can then make the IRA contributions and not withdraw funds from their earned income to do so. This is a great way to pass down assets, reduce your estate, and set a child or grandchild on the path towards a retirement savings that they may continue going forward.

Keep in mind that Congress can change these rules at any time. So while these are the rules today, they may be very different when you retire.

# HOME IMPROVEMENT m a t t e r s

Welcome back! Last month we started with the important topic of insulation. We learned that insulation is measured in "R-values" and that a higher R-value number meant better insulation. Today, we are going to look at four types of insulation products that are popular in our area.

The first is fiberglass batt insulation. Most of us have seen this (it's often cotton candy pink, but that's just one particular brand's color). It's a very effective material for insulation, as well as being cost effective to purchase and install.

Batt insulation is meant to be installed in walls as they are being built. Typical construction calls for wall studs to be 16 inches apart. Batt insulation comes sized to fit between the two wall studs, effectively filling the cavity. In a 2x4 framed wall, the insulation has an R-value of about R-13. Often, outside walls are framed with bigger 2x6 studs to provide more depth for insulation. In a 2x6 wall, you can get an R-value of about R-17. Batt insulation is easy to cut and "fluff" so it's easy to

work around wires, pipes and air condition ducts. The trade off is that it's difficult to completely fill a stud cavity, so you may get thermal "thin spots."

The second type is a newer material, referred to as a spray-in or expanding foam insulation. This material requires a special dispenser (big and often truck mounted) and pumps a liquid foam that will expand and harden. These expanding foams are more expensive to install than batt insulation and only offer about the same R-value per inch's depth. The difference is that the material expands to fill in around the pipes and wires more completely, providing a better fill against drafts and thin spots. These spray-in materials are available in Eco-friendly "Green" formulas, too. While more expensive, spray foam is an excellent way to insulate an attic, helping to prevent ice damming in the winter, when leaking heat melts roof snow during the day, allowing melt water to seep into your roofing materials before colder nights cause refreezing and expensive damage.

Our third material is rigid foam insulation. Often used for specific situations, this material is also easy to work with. It can solve insulation retrofitting problems or just give you an easy way to get some "extra" insulation. Rigid foam, which often includes a foil coating on one side as a moisture barrier, is a main stay of basement refinishing. Outside, it easily allows an extra layer of insulation to be installed under vinyl siding. Depending on the material type, you can add between R-3 and R-6.5 per inch of foam and could bring a typical wall from R-13 to R19!

The fourth type of insulation is blow-in cellulose. This material is also very "Green," being that it's made with recycled, shredded newspapers treated with chemicals to make it flame retardant. It's blown in with giant fans and hoses. This material is often used to add an extra insulation layer in an attic, but can also be used in wall cavities. It's slightly denser than batt insulation, but may settle over time if used in walls, leaving a cold spot at the top of your wall. It's R-value is between 3.6 and 3.8 per inch.

Given the rising cost of energy and heating, insulation is a very important consideration when building or adding on to your home and the most effective insulation systems may be one that uses several materials. Just remember that even though the insulation is not something you'll see every day, the money invested on it during the build will continue to pay you back with cheaper heating costs for the life of the house.



### Before the Snow...Make a Plan


## Understanding Mutual Funds




