





Sprinting his Way to Victory By Teddy Press

Ryder Morello has found the secret to being in two places at once (or at least that's my theory). I honestly don't know how he has time for everything he does. From spring and winter track to cross country to marching band to indoor percussion to brass ensemble, it baffles me how he could possibly run from one activity to the next without missing a beat. And did I forget to mention the sheer amount of homework he has to complete as a high school student? Yeah, he definitely must have a clone or something, because it would take two of me to do that much of anything.

To begin to explain the chronological phenomena that is Ryder, one must first delve into a huge aspect of his life: running. Currently a freshman, he began recreational track in 5th grade, and continued in 6th. The main reason for his joining was to try something new; but it wouldn't hurt to say that running is in his blood, too. When he entered West Essex Middle School, Ryder joined the school-run track team. In high school this past year, he took part in cross country, winter track, and spring track! As a distance runner, Ryder competes in the one and two mile races in spring and winter track; for cross country, every person on the team participates in the same event, the 5K.

Ryder's numerous achievements in track have earned him a reputation as one of

the most athletic students in the district. Earlier this school year, he finished 7th in the entire division for Cross Country, which earned him a title spot on the "1st team" that is comprised of the top 10 runners in the division. When he participated in the "West Essex Trot for Technology" in 8th grade, Ryder earned the gold medal for being the fastest middle schooler in the entire race. Overall, he won seventh place for the two years he partook in the event. For spring track, Ryder took second place in the 2-mile run.

Sports are a mainstay in the Morello family, and have always played an important role in shaping their lifestyle. Ryder used to play soccer and basketball, but has narrowed his focuses to running. All three of his siblings play sports: his younger brother Sebi plays lacrosse, soccer, and basketball; the youngest brother, Logan, plays soccer, football, and basketball; and his sister, Romey, plays soccer and basketball. His dad, along with a large portion of his family, played volleyball, and both his mom and dad played basketball. One of the most prominently active members in Ryder's family is his cousin, Kimarra McDonald. She runs professionally in the World Division, which is one level right below the Olympic Division. Ryder looks up to Kimarra as a friend and an athlete, and she serves as a role model whom Ryder aspires to be like.

Motivations for Ryder include the obvious family, friends, and teammates, but there are two people who really push him to do his best in track. Bryan Gallian and Steven Collini, who run both the one-miler and two-miler alongside Ryder, help him pace, and to keep going when he begins to tire or slow down. As for his parents, they are extremely supportive of anything Ryder wants to do.

However, athletics aren't the only thing Ryder has up his sleeve. He has a passion for music as a member of the West Essex

concert band, marching band, indoor percussion ensemble, and brass ensemble. He plays the trumpet, and has done so all throughout middle school and thus far in high school. Ryder began concert band in 7th grade, marching band in 8th, and indoor percussion and brass ensemble in 9th. These activities have been an extremely positive experience for Ryder, since he has been able to meet upper-classmen and become a better musician overall. All of Ryder's time-consuming activities have forced him to become better with managing his availability, and juggling multiple responsibilities at once.

As a part of West Essex tradition, the entire music program travels down to Orlando, Florida every four years to perform in Disney World. Because he is in the marching band, Ryder got the opportunity to march down Main Street and perform in the parade. He explained that it was cool to be around his friends on a trip, but it was somewhat difficult to perform in the sun and heat that's so common in Florida. Plus, he got to go on the rides afterwards!

Ryder's summer plans include attending sports camps, such as one run by Lisa Morgan, who is an international level coach. He will also be going to Band camp in preparation for the upcoming marching band season. However, the one thing he is most excited about is speed and agility training with his cousin, Kimarra, and the rest of her running team, on Sundays. So even on his break, Ryder will be working hard.

When I asked Ryder if he had any advice about running, I believe the answer he gave could reflect both athleticism, and could be applied to real life situations: "Running long-distance hurts for a while, but you just have to remember that it's not forever, and it will end soon."

Financial Fitness Understanding Mutual Funds

Mutual Funds, though we've all heard of them, can be hard for people to explain.

A mutual fund is "a collection of stocks and/or bonds. You can think of a mutual fund as a company that brings together a group of people and invests their money in stocks, bonds, and other securities. Each investor owns shares, which

represent a portion of the holdings of the fund." [http://www.investopedia.com/university/mutualfunds/mutualfunds.asp]

Because mutual funds are an investment company pooling money from many investors into many investments, each investor owns one or more shares (pieces) of the particular mutual fund. It allows an investor to invest in many companies (stocks), bonds, and funds at the same time without having to invest in each individually. Some mutual funds invest in hundreds, even thousands, of holdings within one fund. There are several types of funds, but three basic types are:

1. Stock funds, investing in stocks.
2. Bond funds, investing in bonds.
3. Balanced funds, investing in a combination of both stocks and bonds in varying amounts.

Mutual funds will typically have a specific strategy which is determined by the fund's objectives. Actively managed funds have a person or team making choices daily for how to invest. The investments are based on these managers' style and skill. Please note there is no guarantee that the managers will meet the funds' stated investment objectives, or turn a profit.

Each shareholder (investor) will receive a portion, relative to the amount of shares owned, of any income and/or capital gains from the dividends and/or interest the mutual fund earns. This occurs when profits are made by the fund, after expenses. As such, investors' returns are determined by fund performance, minus fees. As with all investments, mutual funds contain investment risk, including possible loss of principal invested.

All mutual funds charge fees. They vary by fund, though are typically within a range. Some fees are transactional, while others are ongoing to pay the managers and team. So, returns that investors receive are net of fees paid.

Should holdings not perform well, the value of each share of the mutual fund could go down. And, the investor could lose money should that occur.

The benefit of investing with mutual funds is that they provide diversification – one investment spread to different investment types. The broader the strategy of the fund, the more diversification the investor will experience.

Q&A With A CPA

Q: I am very interested in gifting money to my children and grandchildren. What is the maximum allowed and what procedures would I follow?

A: There is no maximum allowed. However, there may be current or future tax implications. The donor is generally responsible for paying the gift tax. A gift is any transfer to an individual, either directly or indirectly, where full consideration (measured in money or money's worth) is not received in return.

The general rule is that any gift is a taxable gift. However, there are many exceptions to this rule. Generally, the following gifts are not taxable gifts.

1. Gifts that are equal to or lower than the annual exclusion for the calendar year.
2. Tuition or medical expenses you pay for someone (the educational and medical exclusions).
3. Gifts to your spouse.
4. Gifts to a political organization for its use.

In addition, gifts to qualifying charities are deductible from the value of the gift(s) made.

Making a gift or leaving your estate to your heirs does not ordinarily affect your federal income tax. You cannot deduct the value of gifts you make (other than gifts that are deductible charitable contributions).

The annual exclusion applies to gifts by donee. In other words, if you give \$14,000 to each of your children in 2015, the annual exclusion applies to each gift. If you are married, both spouses are entitled to apply the annual exclusion to their respective gifts. Together, you can gift \$28,000 to each donee on or after January 1, 2015. There also is a lifetime exclusion, which increases each year. This exclusion is tied to the Federal Estate Tax that may be due upon one's death.

In considering whether to hire someone to represent you and prepare and file the return there are several factors to consider:

1. How complex is the transfer?
2. How large is the transfer?
3. Do I need an attorney, CPA, Enrolled Agent (EA) or other professional(s)?

For most simple, small transfers (less than the annual exclusion amount) you may not need the services of a professional.

People who make gifts as a part of their overall estate and financial plan often engage the services of professionals. The attorney usually handles wills, trusts, and transfer documents that are involved and reviews the impact of documents on the gift tax return and overall plan. The CPA or EA often handles the actual return preparation and some representation of the donor in matters with the IRS. In addition, other professionals (such as appraisers, surveyors, financial advisors and others) may need to be engaged during this time.

Sports Injuries In Our Active Kids

I'm a doctor that specializes in musculoskeletal injuries and my sons play ice hockey. As a mom and a doctor, I have concerns of possible injury. It wasn't a shock to me when my son got checked into the boards and bruised his knee. It was a shock however, when he came to me complaining of groin pain. He was 8. How could an 8 year old hurt his groin? Could he pull his groin at that age? The answer was more complicated than that.

After normal x-rays and a course of physical therapy and a brief rest period, nothing improved. My son felt great one minute, limping the next. So, to appease myself, I got an MRI and my 8 year old had stress fractures and swelling in his pelvic bone in multiple areas. After 12 weeks of complete rest from skating and all sports he returned to ice hockey and all other sports pain free.

I tell this story to emphasize that kids are not little adults. They don't sprain and strain things as easily as we do. Often their muscles are stronger than their bones and they can pull at the growth plates and cause unexpected injury. There is a very well known condition of the knee called Osgood-Schlatter Disease. It occurs mostly in children ages 9-16. It is mostly a pulling of the quadriceps on the front of the tibia at a sensitive spot called the tibial tubercle. The tubercle starts to pull away from the rest of the tibia due to the force of the quadriceps.

Spondylolysis is a condition of the spine in which a small fracture occurs at a fragile piece of bone called the pars. This condition usually occurs between the ages of 14-26. We see this condition in contact sports and sports like gymnastics where hyperextension of the spine is commonplace.

It is important to take our kids complaints seriously and to look at the activities they are doing and how they might be affecting their bodies. Children have growth plates that make them susceptible to different injuries than we see in adults. They can sustain stress fractures due to muscle imbalance and instability. Teens tend to overuse body parts due to improper technique and again due to muscle imbalance. These types of issues can respond to treatment and recurrent injuries can often be prevented.

HOME IMPROVEMENT matters



For the last few articles we've been taking a trip through your theoretical building project by adding a "new" kitchen and more bedroom space. Last month we talked about outside, with roofing and siding. This month we are going to move inside the walls.

After your addition is framed and before the sheetrock is installed, the next step is to add in what we call the "infrastructure." This infrastructure is the wiring, piping, and duct work that brings electricity, water and heated/cooled air into the living space.

In most cases, construction crews schedule installation from the largest pipes to the smallest wires. This means that the HVAC (Air Conditioning and Forced Hot air heat) duct work goes in first. Some installers use a flexible tube (like you see on clothes dryers) because its cheaper to install, but these tubes can pinch and bind restricting the air flow. (Meaning your system has to work harder so you may pay more in energy costs). Also, these flex tubes are sometimes used in attics and "hung" on wire loops

slightly thicker than clothes hangers. While they hold up in the beginning, eventually they all seem to sag and restrict air flow. The best way to handle this air flow is with metal duct work in preformed pipes and custom formed ducts.

Duct pipes (typically about 5-6 inches in diameter) are installed inside the walls so they won't be seen in the finished room. They lead to a register outlet in the wall. Another type of register is a "return." Returns allows the system to breathe. Your system can't keep blowing out air without getting it from somewhere. A return is where your system "inhales" from.

All these components are attached to a system that includes an air conditioner and, in the case of a forced hot air heating system, a furnace. Since modern systems can control what ducts are open and flowing, we take advantage of this and divide your home into "zones."

A "zone system" is more cost effective to heat and cool your home. Picture a two-story house with bedrooms on the second floor and living space on the first. During the day, the bedrooms are empty and we don't really need to heat or cool them. At night, when the family is asleep, we swap the zones and lower the heating or cooling required in the downstairs (which is empty). This way we lower energy costs by not paying for energy to heat/cool when areas are not in use.

Next we move onto plumbing. Plumbing has four main components to deal with. These are fresh (drinkable) water, waste water (from toilets and drains), gas piping (for stoves, water heaters and furnaces) and in some homes, steam heat.

The first component is used to supply fresh water. When you turn on the tap, you get hot or cold water. This water originates outside the house (well water or at the municipal). From there, it splits. Some of the water goes into a hot water heater or boiler. That line will feed the hot water faucets in the house, while a line right from the main feed will supply the cold water faucets.

During installation, these supplies are run either through copper pipes or in modern construction, flexible tubing referred to as "Pex." Copper is more traditional and makes a solid system, but Pex has the advantage of being easier to install (since you can wiggle it into place) and won't split on the off chance it gets frozen (it flexes).


North Caldwell "Kids With A Passion"

Joey Klein



In costume, Joey wears a vibrant, red wig, colorful, oversized, clown shoes, a theatrical jumpsuit, and of course, a crimson clown nose. As a circus clown, Joey is a part of many circuses including the Cole Brothers, Salaam Shrine, and the Zerbini.

Joey has lived in North Caldwell for 14 years as he formally moved to town in 2001. He feels North Caldwell provides him with large town amenities while still having a small town feel. Joey greatly enjoyed attending both Grandview and Gould Elementary Schools.

Joey is actively involved in the schools masques program and was recently given a lead role in this year's musical, Legally Blonde. Playing the role of a sanctimonious, haughty character, Joey was recognized for his outstanding performance.

Ingredients:

- 2 cups old fashioned oats (rolled / not steel cut)
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 1/8 tsp sea salt
- 1/2 tsp cinnamon
- 2 cups frozen blueberries (you can use fresh too, I like frozen as they're easy to mix with the batter)
- 1 cup milk (almond or rice milk work too)
- 1 egg
- 1 banana mashed (If not ripe, peel and microwave for 20 seconds - taste how sweet this makes your bananas!)
- 2 Tbsp natural sweetener (honey, agave, maple syrup), if making for your baby < 1 year, skip this add-in.
- 1 Tbsp melted coconut oil

Instructions:

Combine all dry ingredients and mix well. Add the wet ingredients (blueberries through coconut oil) and mix. Scoop into greased cupcake tins (I like using coconut oil or butter) and bake at 325 for 25 minutes. This single batch yields about 12 small muffins.




