He is a hardworking businessman, a family role model, and a leader of the Boy Scouts; Paul Holland truly fits the standard of what it means to be a good neighbor.

Born and raised a Jersey Boy, Paul grew up in Teaneck, NJ, later moved to Maryland, then back to Ramsey, where he attended high school. Following high school, he went to Georgia Tech, where his studies focused on technology and marketing. However, Paul did not get to finish his degree because he enlisted in the United States Navy. In the Navy,

he served for three-and-a-half years, eventually working his way up to becoming a petty officer. Paul followed in the footsteps of his father, who was a World War II veteran. 



6. Serve with a sprig of thyme on top.






